

**In order to comply with Fire Marshall regulations, Princeton University is insisting on the following, in order to meet capacity management and fire code requirements:**

- Absolutely NO chairs, coolers or large duffle bags will be allowed to pass through the general admission gate, or to be placed in the spectator seating areas
- DeNunzio Pool may be cleared of all spectators after each day's mid-day distance events (500 FR & 400 I.M.), prior to the 13&Over afternoon session.

Swimmers who are swimming in both the mid-day distance session and the afternoon session will not have to leave the building.

Swimmers competing in the afternoon session **ONLY** will have to wait until the swimmers' entrance opens for the afternoon session.

Please plan accordingly, relative to each day's weather conditions.

- Also, swimmers and spectators are reminded that **NO GLASS** containers are permitted inside DeNunzio Pool.

**Entrance Fees:**

**Two separate entrance fees will be collected each day for this meet:**

- One for the morning 12&Under sessions (allowing attendance through the mid-day distance events, until the building is cleared).
- A second fee will be charged for the afternoon 13&Over sessions, which will be collected at either the start of the mid-day distance session or the start of the afternoon session. Spectators that pay for afternoon attendance at the start of the mid-day sessions, will not have to pay again upon re-entering the building through the turnstiles at the start of the afternoon sessions.
